- On-board technology maturation in-flight experiment monitoring

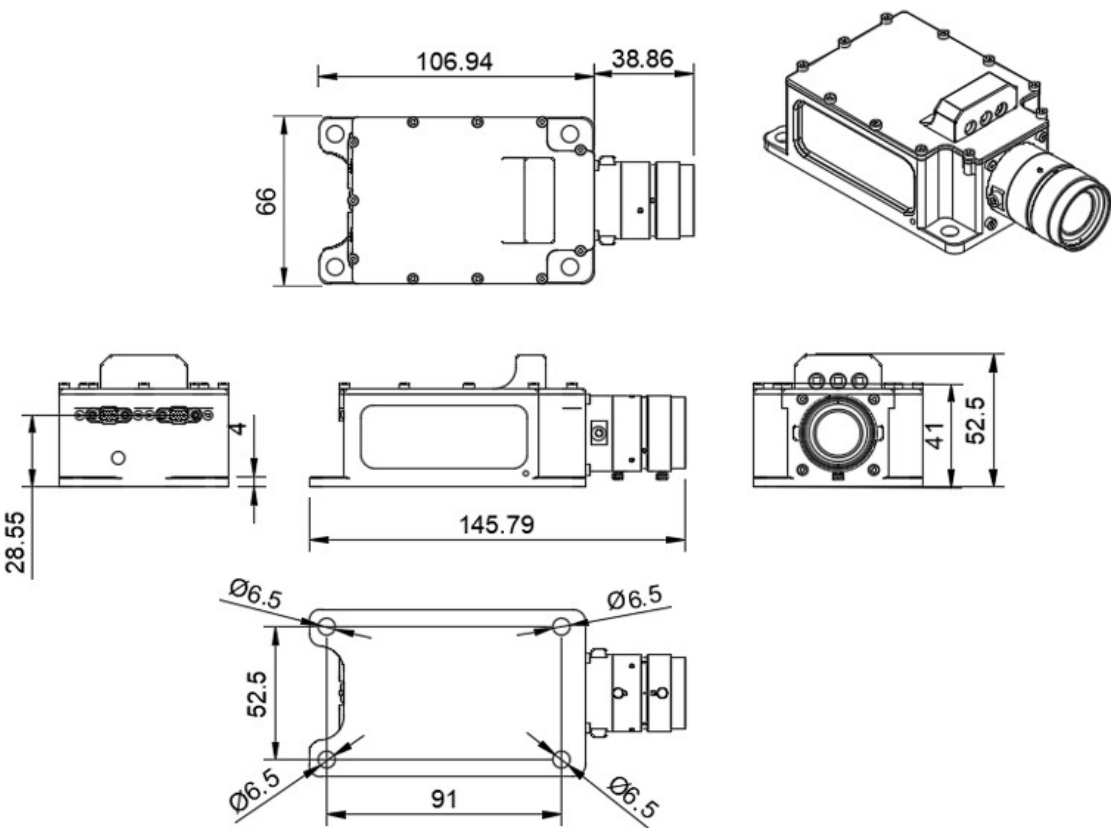

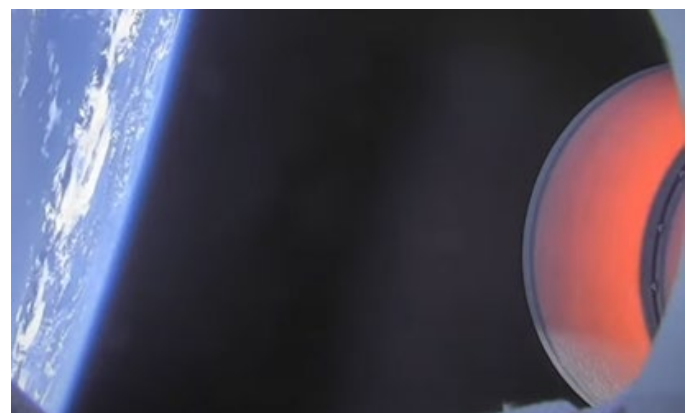
